SAVING ELECTRICITY is as simple as a wire



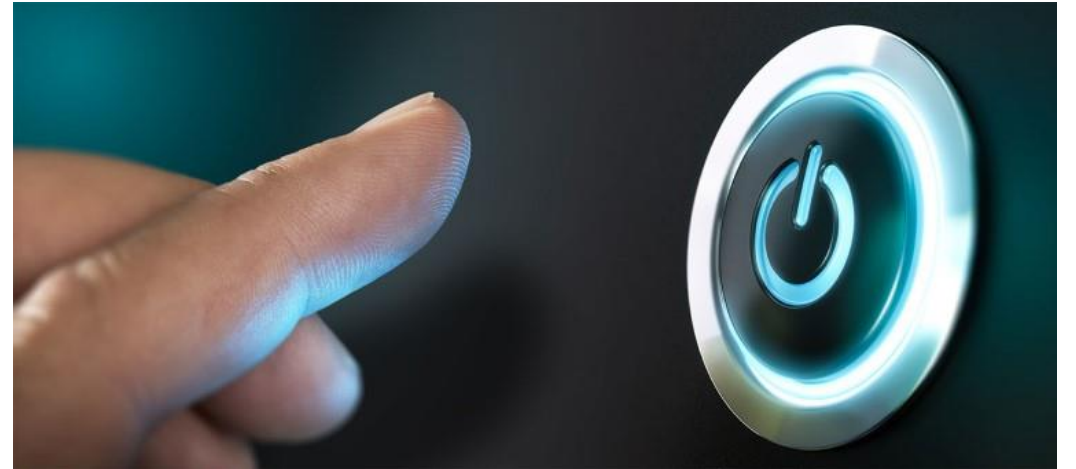


You are not using the device, disconnect it from the power supply.

Do not leave the equipment in standby mode.



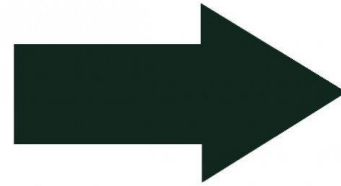
Lit LED

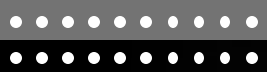

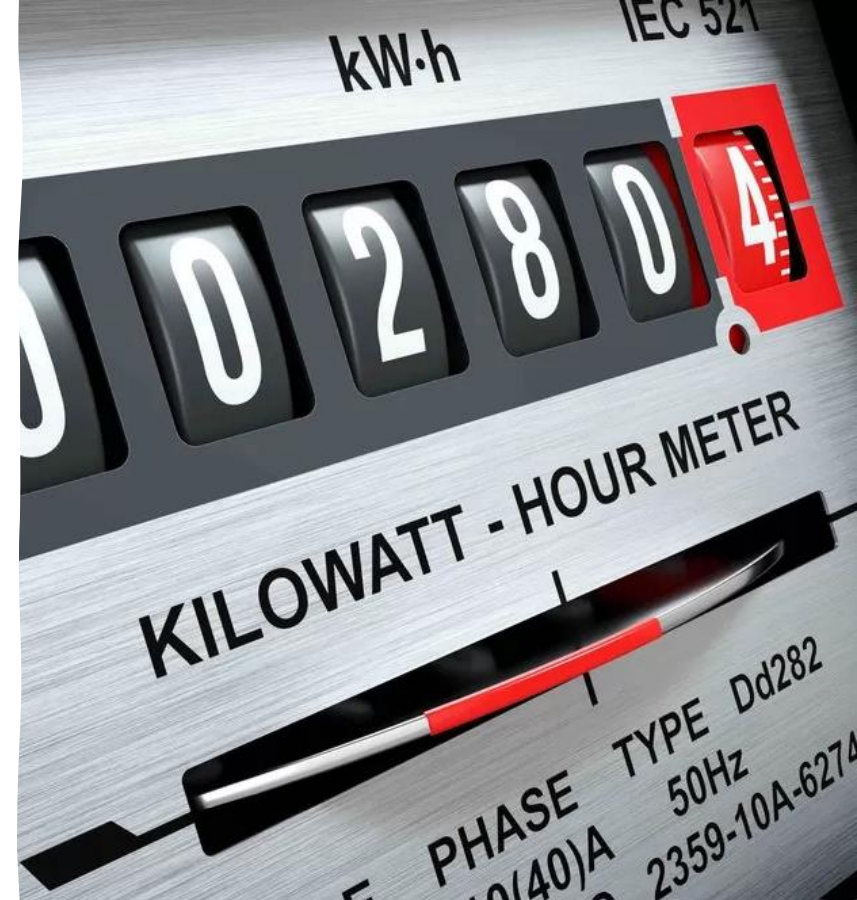


Four-person

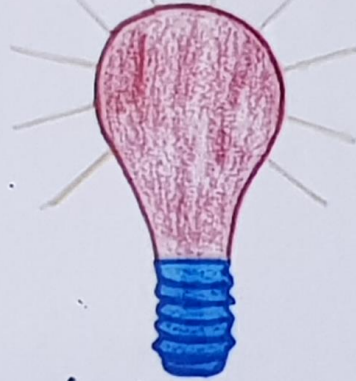
In the winter
